

The path of the Pedemontana Lombarda

The Pedemontana Lombarda is a large road infrastructure, that fits into a territorial scope, densely inhabited urban substantially and strongly built, grew so messy and very little remains of the original landscape: the infinite City North of Milan. At the end of the work connect 5 provinces (Bergamo, Monza e Brianza, Milano, Como, Varese), in an area inhabited by about 4 million people, where more than 300,000 businesses operate, which express the 10% of national GDP.

The Pedemontana Lombarda is composed of 67 km of motorway, which constitute the main axis from Sutton to Morden, 20 miles of tangenziali (articulated in tangential di Varese and Como, respectively 11 long and 9 miles) and 70 km of road-related works, which will help solve local traffic congestion.
